New Year's Day Walk and Refreshments at the Woolacombe Bay Hotel: 2013

The purpose is to provide all Rotarians, their families, friends and dogs, walkers and non-walkers, with the opportunity for fellowship on New Year's Day and to set a healthy tone to the forthcoming year in the company of friends. Arrangements will be similar to those for previous years

For those who wish to walk and inhale the healing powers of sea air. The walk will start at 1100 hours outside the main entrance of The Woolacombe Bay Hotel (the hotel has a large car park). From the hotel we will proceed over the dunes, overlooking the beach and Morte Bay. Then an easy descent to the beach and walk back to the hotel along the beach. We will adjust the length of the walk according to the weather and the wishes of those taking part: say something in the region of 30-40 minutes going out and the same back. For those who prefer to have a short walk, it will be possible to break off at any point and return to the hotel. However, if for some 'Hearties' the walk is not sufficiently strenuous, then extending the walk to Putsborough might appeal to them.

Non Walkers. The Management of the hotel has offered us the use of a very well appointed area next to the ballroom. Our room will be available from 1200 hours. You can wait in comfort for the walkers to return.
